Eligibility	Open to all Nottinghamshire based clubs and clubs receiving an invite from Nottingham Judo. All participants must hold a valid BJA, BJC or AJA licence and must present this when booking in on the day of the event. All participants must wear a white judogi.	
Categories	A: Under 8 Years Randori (players aged 6-7 years) All players will be put into groups of four and will participate in randori with each of their group members. There will be no placing and all will receive a participation medal. B: White and Red Belts (players aged 8-13 years) BJA U12 Restrictions will apply Players aged 9 and over must have completed a grading examination within the last 9 months (applies to novices if licence held over 6 months). C: Yellow Belts (players aged 8-13 years) BJA U12 Restrictions will apply Must have completed a grading examination within the last 6 months. D: Orange & Green Belts (players aged 8-13 years) E: Cadets Green & Below (players aged 14-17 Years) F: Senior Kyu Grades Orange & Below (players aged 18+)	
Method of Elimination	Where possible players will be divided into pools of four in each event based on gender and weight. The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine or alter categories if entries dictate.	
Weigh-In	Category A – 8.30am to 9.00am Category B – 9.00am to 9.30am Categories C & D – 11.00am to 11.30am Categories E & F – 1.00pm to 1.30pm	All competitors MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers, females must also wear a plain white round neck t-shirt.

Closing Date	Saturday 15 June (or when the maximum entry has been reached)

Any lights or flashes should be disabled prior to taking any photographs of action on a contest area. All of our events are now streamed live on facebook, if you do not wish for your contests to be streamed then you must inform the officials at the weigh-in.	
Coach Registration	All coaches will be required to register at the spectator entrance where they should produce their BJA Coach's ID Card and will receive a wristband that will enable them to access the competition area and coaching seating.
